



## System Architecture








# For Every 100 Students

→ [63]	PĀKEHĀ 83	achieved NCEA Level 2 by 18 years of age
93	98	participated in early childhood education
22	2	participate in Māori language in education
65	75	at or above National Standards Reading, Writing, or Maths
68	85	continue at school until 17
30	[11]	leave secondary school without a qualification
27	54	leave school with a university entrance standard
9	29	attain a bachelors level degree by age 25







